

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
5 adding Section 22.54a as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 5/22.54a new)

7 Sec. 22.54a. Disposal of asphalt roofing shingles. No owner
8 or operator of a sanitary landfill that is located within a
9 25-mile radius of a site where asphalt roofing shingles are
10 recycled under a Beneficial Use Determination (BUD) issued by
11 the Agency pursuant to Section 22.54 of this Act shall accept
12 for disposal loads of whole or processed asphalt roofing
13 shingles. Nothing in this Section shall prohibit or restrict a
14 sanitary landfill from accepting for disposal asphalt roofing
15 shingles that are commingled with municipal waste, including,
16 but not limited to, general construction or demolition debris.

17 The Agency shall post on its website the name and address
18 of each site at which the recycling of asphalt roofing shingles
19 under a BUD is approved.

20 No later than January 31 of each year, each recipient of a
21 BUD for asphalt roofing shingles shall submit a report to the
22 Agency that contains the following information: (i) the total
23 quantity of asphalt roofing shingles received under the BUD

1 during the previous calendar year; (ii) the beneficial uses
2 during the previous calendar year of shingles received under
3 the BUD; (iii) the total quantity of shingles used in each
4 beneficial use during the previous calendar year; and (iv) the
5 total quantity and disposition of any shingles received but not
6 beneficially used under the BUD during the previous calendar
7 year. The report must be submitted on a form and in a format
8 prescribed by the Agency.

9 This Section is repealed on February 1, 2018.
