2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 2270 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by

7	Sec. 36-1. Seizure. Any vessel, vehicle or aircraft used
8	with the knowledge and consent of the owner in the commission
9	of, or in the attempt to commit as defined in Section 8-4 of
10	this Code, an offense prohibited by (a) Section 9-1, 9-3, 10-2,
11	11-1.20, 11-1.30, 11-1.40, 11-6, 11-14.4 except for keeping a
12	place of juvenile prostitution, 11-15.1, 11-19.1, 11-19.2,
13	11-20.1, 11-20.1B, 11-20.3, 12-4.1, 12-4.2, 12-4.2-5, 12-4.3,
14	12-4.6, 12-7.3, 12-7.4, 12-13, 12-14, 16-1 if the theft is of
15	precious metal or of scrap metal, 18-2, 19-1, 19-2, 19-3, 20-1,
16	20-2, 24-1.2, 24-1.2-5, 24-1.5, 28-1, or 29D-15.2 of this Code,

1 subdivision (a)(1), (a)(2), (a)(4), (b)(1), (e)(1), (e)(2), 2 (e)(3), (e)(4), (e)(5), (e)(6), or (e)(7) of Section 12-3.05, 3 paragraph (a) of Section 12-4 of this Code, paragraph (a) of 4 Section 11-1.50, paragraph (a) of Section 12-15, paragraph (a), 5 (c), or (d) of Section 11-1.60, or paragraphs (a), (c) or (d) 6 of Section 12-16 of this Code, or paragraph (a)(6) or (a)(7) of Section 24-1 of this Code; (b) Section 21, 22, 23, 24 or 26 of 7 the Cigarette Tax Act if the vessel, vehicle or aircraft 8 9 contains more than 10 cartons of such cigarettes; (c) Section 10 28, 29 or 30 of the Cigarette Use Tax Act if the vessel, 11 vehicle or aircraft contains more than 10 cartons of such cigarettes; (d) Section 44 of the Environmental Protection Act; 12 13 (e) 11-204.1 of the Illinois Vehicle Code; (f) (1) driving under the influence of alcohol or other drug or drugs, 14 15 intoxicating compound or compounds or any combination thereof 16 under Section 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code during a period in which his or her driving privileges are revoked or 17 18 suspended where the revocation or suspension was for driving 19 under the influence of alcohol or other drug or drugs, 20 intoxicating compound or compounds or any combination thereof, Section 11-501.1, paragraph (b) of Section 11-401, or for 21 reckless homicide as defined in Section 9-3 of the Criminal 22 23 Code of 1961 or the Criminal Code of 2012; (2) driving while 24 under the influence of alcohol, other drug or druas, 25 intoxicating compound or compounds or any combination thereof and has been previously convicted of reckless homicide or a 26

1 similar provision of a law of another state relating to reckless homicide in which the person was determined to have 2 been under the influence of alcohol, other drug or drugs, or 3 4 intoxicating compound or compounds as an element of the offense 5 or the person has previously been convicted of committing a 6 violation of driving under the influence of alcohol or other drug or drugs, intoxicating compound or compounds or any 7 combination thereof and was involved in a motor vehicle 8 9 accident that resulted in death, great bodily harm, or 10 permanent disability or disfigurement to another, when the 11 violation was a proximate cause of the death or injuries; (3) the person committed a violation of driving under the influence 12 13 of alcohol or other drug or drugs, intoxicating compound or compounds or any combination thereof under Section 11-501 of 14 15 the Illinois Vehicle Code or a similar provision for the third 16 or subsequent time; (4) the person committed the violation while he or she did not possess a driver's license or permit or 17 a restricted driving permit or a judicial driving permit or a 18 monitoring device driving permit; or (5) the person committed 19 20 the violation while he or she knew or should have known that the vehicle he or she was driving was not covered by a 21 22 liability insurance policy; (g) an offense described in 23 subsection (g) of Section 6-303 of the Illinois Vehicle Code; 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ (h) an offense described in subsection (e) of Section 6-101 25 of the Illinois Vehicle Code; (i) home repair fraud as defined 26 in Section 3 of the Home Repair Fraud Act; or (j) aggravated 09800SB2270ham001

Fraud Act; may be seized and delivered forthwith to the sheriff
of the county of seizure.

Within 15 days after such delivery the sheriff shall give 4 5 notice of seizure to each person according to the following method: Upon each such person whose right, title or interest is 6 of record in the office of the Secretary of State, the 7 Secretary of Transportation, the Administrator of the Federal 8 9 Aviation Agency, or any other Department of this State, or any 10 other state of the United States if such vessel, vehicle or 11 aircraft is required to be so registered, as the case may be, by mailing a copy of the notice by certified mail to the 12 13 address as given upon the records of the Secretary of State, 14 the Department of Aeronautics, Department of Public Works and 15 Buildings or any other Department of this State or the United 16 States if such vessel, vehicle or aircraft is required to be so registered. Within that 15 day period the sheriff shall also 17 18 notify the State's Attorney of the county of seizure about the 19 seizure.

In addition, any mobile or portable equipment used in the commission of an act which is in violation of Section 7g of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District Act shall be subject to seizure and forfeiture under the same procedures provided in this Article for the seizure and forfeiture of vessels, vehicles and aircraft, and any such equipment shall be deemed a vessel, vehicle or aircraft for purposes of this Article. 09800SB2270ham001 -5- LRB098 04465 RLC 45573 a

1 When a person discharges a firearm at another individual from a vehicle with the knowledge and consent of the owner of 2 3 the vehicle and with the intent to cause death or great bodily 4 harm to that individual and as a result causes death or great 5 bodily harm to that individual, the vehicle shall be subject to 6 seizure and forfeiture under the same procedures provided in this Article for the seizure and forfeiture of vehicles used in 7 violations of clauses (a), (b), (c), or (d) of this Section. 8

9 If the spouse of the owner of a vehicle seized for an 10 offense described in subsection (g) of Section 6-303 of the 11 Illinois Vehicle Code, a violation of subdivision (d)(1)(A), (d) (1) (D), (d) (1) (G), (d) (1) (H), or (d) (1) (I) of Section 12 13 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, or Section 9-3 of this Code makes a showing that the seized vehicle is the only source 14 15 of transportation and it is determined that the financial 16 hardship to the family as a result of the seizure outweighs the benefit to the State from the seizure, the vehicle may be 17 forfeited to the spouse or family member and the title to the 18 vehicle shall be transferred to the spouse or family member who 19 20 is properly licensed and who requires the use of the vehicle 21 for employment or family transportation purposes. A written declaration of forfeiture of a vehicle under this Section shall 22 23 be sufficient cause for the title to be transferred to the 24 spouse or family member. The provisions of this paragraph shall 25 apply only to one forfeiture per vehicle. subsequent conviction of either spouse or the family member, the spouse or family member to whom the vehicle was forfeited under the first forfeiture proceeding may not utilize the provisions of this paragraph in another forfeiture proceeding. If the owner of the vehicle seized owns more than one vehicle, the procedure set out in this paragraph may be used for only one vehicle.

8 Property declared contraband under Section 40 of the 9 Illinois Streetgang Terrorism Omnibus Prevention Act may be 10 seized and forfeited under this Article.
