Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Public Health Powers and
 Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
 amended by adding Section 2310-685 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2310/2310-685 new)
- 8 <u>Sec. 2310-685. Health care facility; policy to encourage</u> 9 participation in capital projects.
- 10 <u>(a) A health care facility shall develop a policy to</u>
 11 <u>encourage the participation of minority-owned, women-owned,</u>
 12 <u>veteran-owned, and small business enterprises in capital</u>
- projects undertaken by the health care facility.
- 14 <u>(b) A health care system may develop a system-wide policy</u>
 15 <u>in order to comply with the requirement of subsection (a) of</u>
 16 this Section.
- 17 <u>(c) The policy required under this Section must be</u>
 18 <u>developed no later than 6 months after the effective date of</u>
 19 this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.
- 20 (d) This Section does not apply to health care facilities
 21 with 100 or fewer beds, health care facilities located in a
 22 county with a total census population of less than 3,000,000,
 23 or health care facilities owned or operated by a unit of local

- government or the State or federal government. 1
- 2 (e) For the purpose of this Section, "health care facility"
- has the same meaning as set forth in the Illinois Health 3
- Facilities Planning Act. 4
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 5
- 6 becoming law.
