Amends the School Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning children with specific learning disabilities.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
14-1.03a as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/14-1.03a) (from Ch. 122, par. 14-1.03a)

7 Sec. 14-1.03a. Children with Specific Learning 8 Disabilities. "Children with Specific Learning Disabilities" 9 means children between the the ages of 3 and 21 years who have a disorder in one or more of the basic psychological processes 10 11 involved in understanding or in using language, spoken or written, which disorder may manifest itself in imperfect 12 ability to listen, think, speak, read, write, spell or do 13 14 mathematical calculations. Such disorders include such conditions as perceptual disabilities, brain injury, minimal 15 16 brain dysfunction, dyslexia, and developmental aphasia. Such 17 term does not include children who have learning problems which are primarily the result of visual, hearing or motor 18 19 disabilities, of an intellectual disability, emotional disturbance or environmental disadvantage. 20
