(a) A unit of local government or school district that 8 serves a population of less than 1,000,000 that maintains an 9 10 Internet website other than a social media website or social networking website shall, within 90 days of the effective date 11 of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, post to 12 its website for the current calendar year a mechanism for 13 members of the public to electronically communicate with each 14 15 individual elected official of that unit of local government or 3
