1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Dental Practice Act is amended by adding Section 54.3 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 25/54.3 new)
- 7 Sec. 54.3. Vaccinations; immunizations. Notwithstanding Section 54.2 of this Act, a dentist enrolled in a medical 8 9 network or enrolled as a Medicare or Medicaid provider may administer vaccinations to patients enrolled in the same 10 medical network or enrolled in Medicare or Medicaid upon 11 12 completion of appropriate training on how to address contraindications and adverse reactions. Vaccinations shall be 13 14 limited to patients 18 years of age and older pursuant to a valid prescription or standing order by a physician. In 15 addition, vaccinations shall be limited to influenza 16 17 (inactivated influenza vaccine) with notification to the patient's physician and with appropriate reporting and record 18 19 retention.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
