1 Section 130. The sum of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Savings Institutions Regulatory Fund to the Department of Financial 3 and Professional Regulation for the ordinary and contingent 4 expenses of the Department of Financial and Professional 5 6 Regulation and the Division of Banking, or their successors, 7 in administering and enforcing the Illinois Savings and Loan 8 Act of 1985, the Savings Bank Act, and other laws, rules, and 9 regulations apply to the administration as may 10 enforcement of the foregoing laws, rules, and regulations, as 11 amended from time to time.

Section 135. The sum of \$964,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Fund to the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation for all costs associated with operational expenses of the department in relation to the regulation of medical marijuana.

Section 140. The sum of \$2,057,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Professions Dedicated Fund to the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to the Boards of Trustees of the following public universities for costs associated with the development, support and administration of pharmacy practice
