1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 62

AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend Senate Joint Resolution 62, AS AMENDED, by replacing everything after the heading with the following:

5 "WHEREAS, Emergency responders are constantly placed in 6 danger while performing their duties, both from the dangerous 7 conditions of their work and the hazardous locations where 8 incidents occur; and

9 WHEREAS, On March 5, 2013, Hudson Community Fire Protection 10 District volunteer firefighter Chris Brown was struck and 11 killed by a motorist while working at the scene of a motor 12 vehicle collision; and

13 WHEREAS, On October 30, 2013, Pontiac Police Department K9 14 Officer Casey Kohlmeier was struck and killed by a drunk driver 15 while performing his duties on Interstate 55; and SJ0062SAM007

WHEREAS, Many other emergency responders have been killed,
injured, or placed in needless danger by similar incidents; and

3 WHEREAS, More comprehensive solutions are required to 4 ensure that emergency responders are able to safely perform the 5 vital duties they carry out for the citizens of our State; 6 therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL 8 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 9 CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the Emergency 10 Responder Roadway Safety Task Force to identify and recommend 11 ways that the State of Illinois can increase the safety of 12 emergency responders while they perform their duties; and be it 13 further

That the Task Force shall consist of the 14 RESOLVED, 15 following members: one member appointed by the Speaker of the 16 House of Representatives; one member appointed by the Minority 17 Leader of the House of Representatives; one member appointed by 18 the President of the Senate; one member appointed by the 19 Minority Leader of the Senate; 2 members appointed by the 20 Secretary of the Illinois Department of Transportation, one of 21 which must be currently employed as a highway maintainer with 22 Illinois Department of Transportation; one the member SJ0062SAM007

1 appointed by the Director of the Illinois State Police; one 2 police officer from a county with a population of less than 60,000 citizens appointed by an association that represents law 3 4 enforcement; one police officer from a county with a population 5 60,000 and 1,000,000 citizens appointed between by an 6 association that represents law enforcement; one police officer from a county with a population of more than 1,000,000 7 8 citizens appointed by an association that represents law enforcement; one firefighter from a county with a population of 9 10 less than 60,000 citizens appointed by an association that 11 represents firefighters; one firefighter from a county with a population between 60,000 and 1,000,000 citizens appointed by 12 13 an association that represents firefighters; one firefighter from a county with a population of more than 1,000,000 citizens 14 15 appointed by an association that represents firefighters; one 16 emergency medical services personnel from a county with a population of less than 60,000 citizens appointed by an 17 18 association that represents emergency medical services 19 personnel; one emergency medical services personnel from a 20 county with a population between 60,000 and 1,000,000 citizens 21 appointed by an association that represents emergency medical 22 services personnel; one emergency medical services personnel 23 from a county with a population of more than 1,000,000 citizens 24 appointed by an association that represents emergency medical 25 services personnel; one member appointed by the Executive 26 Director of the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority; and one

1 member appointed by the Professional Towing and Recovery 2 Operators of Illinois; the members of the Task Force shall 3 select a chairperson at the initial meeting; and be it further

4 RESOLVED, That the Illinois State Police shall provide 5 administrative and other support to the Task Force; and be it 6 further

RESOLVED, That the members of the Task Force shall servewithout compensation; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall submit a report of its 10 findings and recommendations to the General Assembly no later 11 than January 1, 2015.".
