WHEREAS, Bradley Demuzio was born on September 3, 1964 in Carlinville; his parents were former Illinois State Senators Vince Demuzio and Deanna (nee Clemonds) Demuzio; and

WHEREAS, Bradley Demuzio had a long and distinguished career as a public servant; from 1984 to 1986, he worked in the Child Support Division of the Cook County State's Attorney's Office; from 1986 to 1999, he worked as a criminal investigator for the Illinois Attorney General's office; on February 16, 1999, he began serving at the Illinois Secretary of State Police as the Chief Deputy Director; in 2002, he began serving as Director of the Secretary of State Police, where he served until his passing; he also represented Secretary White on the Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention Council and served as Mayor of Carlinville from 1993 to 2005; and
