9 <u>(a) Whenever the Department of Natural Resources</u> 10 <u>determines that the public use or public interest will be</u> 11 <u>served by vacating any plat of subdivision, street, roadway, or</u> 12 <u>driveway, or part thereof, located within Department owned</u> 13 <u>lands, it may vacate that plat of subdivision, street, roadway,</u> 14 or driveway, or part thereof, by approval of the Governor.

(b) The determination of the Department that the nature and 15 16 extent of the public use or public interest to be served 17 warrants the vacation of any plat of subdivision, street, roadway, or driveway, or part thereof, is conclusive, and the 18 19 approval of the vacation is sufficient evidence of that 20 determination, whether so recited in the vacation or not. The 21 relief to the public from further burden and responsibility of 22 maintaining any plat of subdivision, street, roadway, or driveway, or part thereof, constitutes a public use or public 23

2	(c) Nothing contained in this Section shall be construed to
3	authorize the Department to vacate any plat of subdivision,
4	street, roadway, or driveway, or part thereof, that is part of

8	appropriate county highway department (in the case of a county

10	(d) Title to the land in fee simple included within the
