10 Section 34. The sum of \$488,800, or as much thereof is
11 necessary is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
12 the Department of Human Services for a pilot program to study
13 uses and effects of medication assisted treatments for
14 addiction and for the prevention of relapse to opioid
15 dependence in publicly-funded treatment program.

16 Section 34.5. The following named amounts, or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
18 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Department of
19 Human Services for Family and Community Services and related
20 distributive purposes, including such Federal funds as are
21 made available by the Federal government for the following
22 purposes:
