Amend House Bill 5527 on page 2, by 3 replacing lines 17 through 20 with the following: 4 "(b) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, any individual or person violating this Act by failing to provide 5 his or her PTIN shall pay a civil penalty to the Department in 6 7 the amount of \$50 per offense, but not to exceed \$25,000 per 8 calendar year; however, no such penalty shall be imposed if it 9 is shown that the failure is due to reasonable cause and not

due to willful neglect, as determined by the Department.".
