### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/1A-16.5

Amends the Election Code. Provides that all applications submitted on a website maintained by the State Board of Elections shall be deemed timely filed if they are submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. on the 16th day (instead of on the final day for voter registration) prior to an election. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning elections.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
1A-16.5 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/1A-16.5)

Sec. 1A-16.5. Online voter registration.

(a) The State Board of Elections shall establish and 8 9 maintain a system for online voter registration that permits a person to apply to register to vote or to update his or her 10 existing voter registration. In accordance with technical 11 specifications provided by the State Board of Elections, each 12 election authority shall maintain a voter registration system 13 14 capable of receiving and processing voter registration application information, including electronic signatures, from 15 16 the online voter registration system established by the State Board of Elections. 17

(b) The online voter registration system shall employ security measures to ensure the accuracy and integrity of voter registration applications submitted electronically pursuant to this Section.

(c) The Board may receive voter registration informationprovided by applicants using the State Board of Elections'

website, may cross reference that information with data or information contained in the Secretary of State's database in order to match the information submitted by applicants, and may receive from the Secretary of State the applicant's digitized signature upon a successful match of that applicant's information with that contained in the Secretary of State's database.

8 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person 9 who is qualified to register to vote and who has an authentic 10 Illinois driver's license or State identification card issued 11 by the Secretary of State may submit an application to register 12 to vote electronically on a website maintained by the State 13 Board of Elections.

14 (e) An online voter registration application shall contain 15 all of the information that is required for a paper application 16 as provided in Section 1A-16 of this Code, except that the 17 applicant shall be required to provide:

18 (1) the applicant's full Illinois driver's license or
19 State identification card number;

20 (2) the last 4 digits of the applicant's social
 21 security number; and

(3) the date the Illinois driver's license or Stateidentification card was issued.

(f) For an applicant's registration or change in
registration to be accepted, the applicant shall mark the box
associated with the following statement included as part of the

1 online voter registration application:

2 "By clicking on the box below, I swear or affirm all of the 3 following:

4 (1) I am the person whose name and identifying information
5 is provided on this form, and I desire to register to vote in
6 the State of Illinois.

7 (2) All the information I have provided on this form is
8 true and correct as of the date I am submitting this form.

9 (3) I authorize the Secretary of State to transmit to the 10 State Board of Elections my signature that is on file with the 11 Secretary of State and understand that such signature will be 12 used by my local election authority on this online voter 13 registration application for admission as an elector as if I 14 had signed this form personally.".

15 (g) Immediately upon receiving a completed online voter 16 registration application, the online voter registration system 17 shall send, by electronic mail, a confirmation notice that the application has been received. Within 48 hours of receiving 18 19 such an application, the online voter registration system shall 20 send by electronic mail, a notice informing the applicant of whether the following information has been matched with the 21 Secretary of State database: 22

(1) that the applicant has an authentic Illinois
driver's license or State identification card issued by the
Secretary of State and that the driver's license or State
identification number provided by the applicant matches

the driver's license or State identification card number for that person on file with the Secretary of State;

3 (2) that the date of issuance of the Illinois driver's 4 license or State identification card listed on the 5 application matches the date of issuance of that card for 6 that person on file with the Secretary of State;

7 (3) that the date of birth provided by the applicant
8 matches the date of birth for that person on file with the
9 Secretary of State; and

10 (4) that the last 4 digits of the applicant's social
11 security number matches the last 4 digits for that person
12 on file with the Secretary of State.

(h) If the information provided by the applicant matches the information on the Secretary of State's databases for any driver's license and State identification card holder and is matched as provided in subsection (g) above, the online voter registration system shall:

(1) retrieve from the Secretary of State's database 18 files an electronic copy of the applicant's signature from 19 Illinois 20 driver's license his or her or State 21 identification card and such signature shall be deemed to 22 be the applicant's signature on his or her online voter 23 registration application;

(2) within 2 days of receiving the application, forward
to the county clerk or board of election commissioners
having jurisdiction over the applicant's voter

registration: (i) 1 the application, along with the 2 applicant's relevant data that can be directly loaded into the jurisdiction's voter registration system and (ii) a 3 copy of the applicant's electronic signature and a 4 5 certification from the State Board of Elections that the applicant's driver's license or State identification card 6 number, driver's license or State identification card date 7 issuance, and date of birth and social security 8 of 9 information have been successfully matched.

10 (i) Upon receipt of the online voter registration 11 application, the county clerk or board of election 12 commissioners having jurisdiction over the applicant's voter 13 registration shall promptly search its voter registration 14 database to determine whether the applicant is already 15 registered to vote at the address on the application and 16 whether the new registration would create a duplicate 17 registration. If the applicant is already registered to vote at the address on the application, the clerk or board, as the case 18 may be, shall send the applicant by first class mail, and 19 electronic mail if the applicant has provided an electronic 20 mail address on the original voter registration form for that 21 22 address, a disposition notice as otherwise required by law 23 informing the applicant that he or she is already registered to 24 vote at such address. If the applicant is not already 25 registered to vote at the address on the application and the 26 applicant is otherwise eligible to register to vote, the clerk

1 or board, as the case may be, shall:

(1) enter the name and address of the applicant on the list of registered voters in the jurisdiction; and

4 (2) send by mail, and electronic mail if the applicant 5 has provided an electronic mail address on the voter 6 registration form, a disposition notice to the applicant as 7 otherwise provided by law setting forth the applicant's 8 name and address as it appears on the application and 9 stating that the person is registered to vote.

10 (j) An electronic signature of the person submitting a 11 duplicate registration application or a change of address form 12 that is retrieved and imported from the Secretary of State's 13 driver's license or State identification card database as provided herein may, in the discretion of the clerk or board, 14 15 be substituted for and replace any existing signature for that 16 individual in the voter registration database of the county 17 clerk or board of election commissioners.

(k) Any new registration or change of address submitted 18 19 electronically as provided in this Section shall become 20 effective as of the date it is received by the county clerk or board of election commissioners having jurisdiction over said 21 22 registration. Disposition notices prescribed in this Section 23 shall be sent within 5 business days of receipt of the online application or change of address by the county clerk or board 24 25 of election commissioners.

26 (1) All provisions of this Code governing voter

registration and applicable thereto and not inconsistent with 1 2 this Section shall apply to online voter registration under a website 3 this Section. All applications submitted on maintained by the State Board of Elections shall be deemed 4 5 timely filed if they are submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. on 6 the <u>16th day</u> final day for voter registration prior to an 7 election. After the registration period for an upcoming 8 election has ended and until the 2nd day following such 9 election, the web page containing the online voter registration 10 form on the State Board of Elections website shall inform users 11 of the procedure for grace period voting.

(m) The State Board of Elections shall maintain a list of the name, street address, e-mail address, and likely precinct, ward, township, and district numbers, as the case may be, of people who apply to vote online through the voter registration system and those names and that information shall be stored in an electronic format on its website, arranged by county and accessible to State and local political committees.

(n) The Illinois State Board of Elections shall develop or
cause to be developed an online voter registration system able
to be accessed by at least the top two most used mobile
electronic operating systems by January 1, 2016.

(p) Each State department that maintains an Internet website must include a hypertext link to the homepage website maintained and operated pursuant to this Section 1A-16.5. For HB5677 - 8 - LRB099 18427 MLM 42803 b

the purposes of this Section, "State department" means the departments of State Government listed in Section 5-15 of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois (General Provisions and Departments of State Government).
