Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Board of Higher Education and the Illinois Math and Science Academy for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, as follows:

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet  
9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending  
10 June 30, 2017:

11	For Personal Services .....	2,072,600
12	For State Contributions to Social	
13	Security, for Medicare .....	30,100
14	For Contractual Services .....	320,600
15	For Travel .....	48,900
16	For Commodities .....	10,900
17	For Printing .....	8,300
18	For Equipment .....	10,300

20	For Operation of Automotive Equipment .....	<u>3,900</u>
21	Total	\$2,539,800

1 Section 10. The sum of \$404,000, or so much thereof as  
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 3 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses  
 4 associated with the administration and enforcement associated  
 5 with the P-20 Longitudinal Education Data System Act.

6 Section 15. The sum of \$115,000, or so much thereof as  
 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 8 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated  
 9 with the Midwest Higher Education Compact.

10 Section 20. The sum of \$203,700, or so much thereof as  
 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 12 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated  
 13 with the u.Select System.

14 Section 25. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 15 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the General  
 16 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for  
 17 Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (S.T.E.M.)  
 18 diversity initiatives to enhance S.T.E.M. programs for  
 19 students from underrepresented groups:

- 20 Illinois Mathematics and Science
- 21 Academy Excellence 2000 Program
- 22 in Mathematics and Science .....106,500

1 Section 30. The sum of \$1,089,400, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as  
4 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of  
5 higher education.

6 Section 35. The sum of \$1,065,000, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
8 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the  
9 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for  
10 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

11 Section 40. The sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
13 Assistance Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the  
14 distribution of grants to public universities based on  
15 performance-based goals.

16 Section 45. The sum of \$30,000 or so much thereof as may  
17 be necessary, is appropriated from the Distance Learning Fund  
18 to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for  
19 13 costs and expenses associated with the administration and  
20 14 enforcement of 110 ILCS 145/40.

1           Section 50. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic  
3 Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as  
4 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with  
5 the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.

6           Section 55. The amount of \$80,000, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College  
8 Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher  
9 Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses  
10 associated with the administration and enforcement of 110  
11 ILCS 1005.

12           Section 60. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business  
14 and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of  
15 Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and  
16 expenses associated with the administration and enforcement  
17 of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.

18           Section 65. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as  
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants  
20 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under  
21 the terms and conditions associated with the federal  
22 contracts and grants moneys received.

1 Section 70. The following named amounts, or so much  
 2 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
 3 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
 4 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and  
 5 Science Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for  
 6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017:

21 Section 75. The following named amounts, or so much  
 22 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
 23 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the

1 IMSA Income Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science  
 2 Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
 3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2017:

6	Security, for Medicare .....	45,900
7	For Contractual Services .....	294,700
8	For Travel .....	126,700
9	For Commodities .....	143,200

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July  
 16 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99<sup>th</sup> General  
 17 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced  
 18 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
