Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, as follows:

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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal
9 Justice Information Authority:

12 Section 15. The sum of \$42,500,000, or so much thereof
 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
 14 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 15 Information Authority for awards and grants to local units of
 16 government and non-profit organizations.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
 19 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 20 Information Authority for awards and grants to state
 21 agencies.

1 Section 25. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
 3 Criminal Justice Information Authority for activities
 4 undertaken in support of federal assistance programs
 5 administered by units of state and local government and non-
 6 profit organizations:

7 Payable from the Criminal Justice
 8 Trust Fund.....5,847,300

9 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much
 10 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
 11 Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards and grants
 12 and other monies received from federal agencies, from other
 13 units of government, and from private/not-for-profit
 14 organizations for activities undertaken in support of
 15 investigating issues in criminal justice and for undertaking
 16 other criminal justice information projects:

22 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much
 23 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects

1 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the
 2 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards,
 3 grants and operational support to implement the Motor Vehicle
 4 Theft Prevention Act:

19 Section 40. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois State
 21 Crime Stoppers Association Fund to the Illinois Criminal
 22 Justice Information Authority for grants to enhance and
 23 develop Crime Stoppers programs in Illinois.

1 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much
 2 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
 3 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the
 4 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the
 5 training of law enforcement personnel and services for
 6 families of homicide or murder:

7 Payable from the Death Penalty Abolition Fund:

20 Section 50. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Prescription Pill
 22 and Drug Disposal Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 23 Information Authority for the purpose of collection,
 24 transportation, and incineration of pharmaceuticals by local

1 law enforcement agencies.

2 Section 55. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
4 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and
5 contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice
6 Information Authority:

22 Section 60. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
23 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
2 for the purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of
3 the Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

4 Section 65. The amount of \$525,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
7 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council
8 Program.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
10 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
11 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
12 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
