- 3 WHEREAS, A 2.5% increase in distribution fees for craft
- 4 beer breweries should be considered to fund childcare centers
- 5 at State universities that receive a lower amount of State
- 6 appropriations; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The funds generated from the 2.5% increase should
- 8 be evenly allocated to Chicago State University, Northeastern
- 9 Illinois University, and Governor's State University; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Funding childcare facilities means creating space
- 11 for a center or expanding existing facilities, paying salaries
- 12 of childcare teachers, and providing equipment needed to create
- 13 a healthy environment for all children while their parents
- 14 attend classes; and
- 15 WHEREAS, These monies would increase the graduation and
- 16 retention rate for students who attend these institutions; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The funds generated from the 2.5% increase in
- 18 distribution fees for craft beer breweries will remove a
