4 Patrick Frickey of Fairbury, who passed away on December 10,
5 2016; and

6 WHEREAS, Michael Frickey was born in Evergreen Park to
7 Willard and Mary Mullman Frickey on April 8, 1958; he attended
8 Eurkea College and married Cynthia A. Clausen in Dwight on
9 September 29, 1979; and

10 WHEREAS, Michael Frickey was a career police officer,
11 serving the Livingston County area; he was a Livingston County
12 Sheriff's Deputy from 1979 to 1992 and an officer for the
13 Fairbury Police Department from 1992 to 2016, serving as Chief
14 from 2013 to 2016; and

15 WHEREAS, Michael Frickey was the past President of
16 Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #186, a DARE officer, a Prairie
17 Central High School resource officer, and a member of the
18 Livingston County ERU team and Livingston County Proactive
19 units; he was one of the founders of the CIFL program and a
20 volunteer football coach for many years; he was a member of St.
21 Andrew Catholic Church in Fairbury; and

2 of his lifelong dreams, to see the Chicago Cubs win the World
3 Series; and

4 WHEREAS, Michael Frickey was preceded in death by his
5 parents; and
