1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 125

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 125 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended by  
5 changing Section 3.01 as follows:

6 (510 ILCS 70/3.01) (from Ch. 8, par. 703.01)

7 Sec. 3.01. Cruel treatment. No person or owner may beat,  
8 cruelly treat, torment, starve, overwork or otherwise abuse any  
9 animal.

10 No owner may abandon any animal where it may become a  
11 public charge or may suffer injury, hunger or exposure.

12 No owner of a dog or cat may expose the dog or cat in a  
13 manner that places the dog or cat in a life-threatening  
14 situation for a prolonged period of time in extreme heat or  
15 cold conditions.

16 A person convicted of violating this Section is guilty of a

1 Class A misdemeanor. A second or subsequent conviction for a  
2 violation of this Section is a Class 4 felony. In addition to  
3 any other penalty provided by law, upon conviction for  
4 violating this Section, the court may order the convicted  
5 person to undergo a psychological or psychiatric evaluation and  
6 to undergo any treatment at the convicted person's expense that  
7 the court determines to be appropriate after due consideration  
8 of the evidence. If the convicted person is a juvenile or a  
9 companion animal hoarder, the court must order the convicted  
10 person to undergo a psychological or psychiatric evaluation and  
11 to undergo treatment that the court determines to be  
12 appropriate after due consideration of the evaluation.
