1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 564

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 564 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Gubernatorial Boards and Commissions Act is
5 amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 50/10)

7 Sec. 10. Repository of board and commission membership;
8 meeting notices.

9 (a) The Office shall establish and maintain on the Internet
10 a centralized, searchable database, freely accessible to the
11 public, of information relating to appointed positions on the
12 State's boards and commissions.

13 The database shall include, at a minimum:

14 (1) The qualifications for, and the powers, duties, and
15 responsibilities of, each appointed position on each of the
16 State's boards and commissions.

1 (2) The name and term of each current appointed member
2 of a board or commission.

3 (3) Each current vacancy in appointed membership of
4 each of the State's boards and commissions.

5 (4) Information as to how a person may apply for
6 appointment to a board or commission, including a uniform
7 application that may be downloaded and printed or that may
8 be submitted electronically. Such application shall
9 include a data field where an applicant shall disclose his
10 or her ethnicity, gender and disability status for
11 reporting purposes.

12 (5) A link to that section of the Secretary of State's
13 website that allows the public to search Statements of
14 Economic Interest filed with the Secretary of State.

15 (b) In addition to the requirements of subsection (a) of
16 this Section, the Office shall establish and maintain on the
17 Internet:

18 (1) a centralized location for an electronic mail
19 listserv for subscribers to receive notices of the meetings
20 of each board and commission and the meeting's agenda; and

21 (2) a listing of the meeting times and agendas for each
22 board and commission.

23 The Office shall send and post meeting notices and agendas
24 pursuant to paragraphs (1) and (2) at least 48 hours before
25 each meeting. For the purposes of this subsection (b),
26 "electronic mail listserv" means an automatic mailing list

1 server used to manage electronic mail transmissions to a list
2 of subscribers.
