Diploma Programme subjects shall be accepted for credit to 1 2 satisfy degree requirements by all institutions of higher 3 education. Each institution of higher education shall determine for each Advanced Placement test and International 4 5 Baccalaureate Diploma Programme subject whether credit will be granted for electives, general education requirements, or 6 7 and the Advanced Placement major requirements and 8 International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme subject scores 9 required to grant credit for those purposes.

10 (c) By the conclusion of the 2020-2021 2019 2020 academic 11 year, the Board of Higher Education, in cooperation with the 12 Illinois Community College Board, shall analyze the Advanced 13 Placement examination and International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme subject score course granting policy of 14 each 15 institution of higher education and the research used by each 16 institution in determining the level of credit and the number 17 credits provided for the Advanced of Placement and International Baccalaur<u>eate Diploma Programme subject</u> scores 18 19 in accordance with the requirements of this Section and file a 20 report that includes findings and recommendations to the General Assembly and the Governor. Each institution of higher 21 22 education shall provide the Board of Higher Education and the 23 Illinois Community College Board with all necessary data, in 24 accordance with the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, to conduct the analysis. 25
