SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1605/7.18 new

Amends the Illinois Lottery Law. Provides that the identity of a recipient of a prize may not be disclosed without the consent of the recipient. Provides that the awarding of a prize may not be conditioned upon disclosure of the identity of the recipient.

- 5 Section 7.18 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 7.18. Disclosure of identity of winners. The
- 8 Department may not disclose to the public the name of any
- 9 recipient of a prize unless the recipient consents in writing
- 10 to the disclosure. The Department may not condition the
- 11 <u>awarding of any prize upon the disclosure of the identity of</u>
- 12 the recipient.
