5 WHEREAS, Dr. Dickens was born in Aurora to William and 6 Elizabeth Dickens and was a lifelong resident of St. Charles; 7 he graduated from Marmion Academy in 1958 and from the 8 University of Dayton in 1962; he received his Doctorate in 9 Dental Surgery from Marquette University in 1966; he served in 10 the United States Army, stationed in Korea at Camp Irwin; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Dickens returned to his home town and opened 11 12 his dental practice in downtown St. Charles in December of 13 1969; his practice was not just work, but his passion; he loved 14 each of his patients and they, along with his staff, became his second family; he served on the board of the Heritage Center in 15 St. Charles and the Norris Center in St. Charles and was a 16 17 member of St. John Neumann Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, the American Legion, and the St. Charles Country 18 19 Club; he volunteered his time and talent with his wife in 20 Guatemala and at the girls school in Geneva; and
