WHEREAS, Dr. Adair was born in Decatur on November 4, 1953 to Floyd "Bud" and Kathleen "Kay" Adair; he graduated from Belleville West High School in 1971 and from the University of Tennessee in Chattanooga in 1975, where he was an accomplished member of the men's tennis team; he then enrolled in the Southern Illinois University School of Medicine in Springfield; he married Nancy Dawson on June 17, 1978 in Springfield; and
