WHEREAS, Arthur Walker served in the United States Army from 1957 to 1960; and

WHEREAS, Arthur Walker worked as a police officer for the City of Lake Forest for over 10 years until March of 1975, when he accepted the newly-created position of Chief Investigator for the Lake County State's Attorney's Office; his first duty while working for State's Attorney Jack Hoogaisian was to establish a complete criminal investigative unit; within 30 days, the unit was in place and it remains in operation today; and
