SENATE RESOLUTION

13 WHEREAS, Citizens of our State and nation have great trust 14 in the high-quality care nurse practitioners provide, 15 resulting in more than 870 million patient visits annually to 16 nurse practitioners across the country; and

WHEREAS, Five decades of research demonstrates the high quality of care provided by nurse practitioners; and

3 WHEREAS, Nurse practitioners practice in settings 4 including hospital inpatient clinics, private group practices, 5 long-term care facilities, mental health facilities and many 6 others; and

7 WHEREAS, Better utilization of nurse practitioners creates 8 a more accessible, efficient, cost-effective, and higher 9 quality health care system; and

10 WHEREAS, Illinois is proud to recognize and honor the 11 service of nurse practitioners to our State; therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL 13 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare November 13 14 -19, 2016 as Nurse Practitioner Week in the State of Illinois 15 in recognition of the countless contributions that nurse 16 practitioners have made over the past half century and will 17 continue to make to the health and well-being of citizens in 18 our State; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be 20 presented to the Illinois Nurses Association and the Illinois 21 Society for Advanced Practice Nursing.
