- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Abortion Law of 1975 is amended
- 5 by adding Section 6.5 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 510/6.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 6.5. Minor resident of another state.</u>
- 8 (a) In this Section, "minor" means a female under 18
- 9 years of age.
- 10 (b) If (i) a minor who is a resident of a state
- 11 bordering this State comes to this State for the purpose and
- 12 <u>with the intention of obtaining an abortion and (ii) there is</u>
- 13 <u>in effect in that other state a law requiring parental</u>
- 14 consent or parental notification before an abortion may be
- 15 performed on the minor, then the minor may not obtain an
- 16 <u>abortion in this State until there is compliance with that</u>
- 17 parental consent or parental notification law.
- 18 <u>(c) A minor who is a resident of a state bordering this</u>
- 19 State, who comes to this State for the purpose and with the
- 20 <u>intention of obtaining an abortion without parental consent</u>
- 21 <u>in order to avoid complying with a parental consent or</u>
- 22 <u>parental notification law of that other state, and who</u>
- obtains an abortion in this State commits a Class 4 felony.
- 24 (d) A physician who performs an abortion on a minor,
- 25 knowing that the minor is a resident of a state bordering
- 26 this State and has come to this State for the purpose and
- 27 <u>with the intention of obtaining an abortion without parental</u>
- 28 <u>consent in order to avoid complying with a parental consent</u>
- 29 <u>or parental notification law of that other state, commits a</u>
- 30 <u>Class 4 felony.</u>
