- 1 AN ACT in relation to public employee benefits.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 17-125 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/17-125) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 17-125)
- 7 Sec. 17-125. Refund of contributions. Upon certification
- 8 by the Employer of his resignation or cancellation of his
- 9 teaching certificate prior to completion of the minimum term
- 10 of service required to establish eligibility for a pension
- 11 and on written application therefor, a teacher shall be paid
- 12 a refund of all the amounts he has contributed to the Fund,
- 13 less any former refund that has not been repaid, together
- 14 with interest thereon at the rate of 5% per annum, compounded
- 15 <u>annually</u>.
- 16 Upon certification by the Employer of his resignation or
- 17 cancellation of his teaching certificate after completion of
- 18 the minimum term of service required to establish eligibility
- 19 for a pension and on written application therefor, a teacher
- shall be paid a refund of all the amounts he has contributed,
- 21 less (1) any former refund that has not been repaid, and (2)
- 22 pension payments received, provided he has executed and
