AN ACT concerning the regulation of professions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Private Detective, Private Alarm, Private
Security, and Locksmith Act of 1993 is amended by changing
Section 40 as follows:

7 (225 ILCS 446/40)

Sec. 40. Home Rule preemption. Pursuant to paragraph 8 (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution 9 of 1970, the power to regulate the private detective, private 10 security, private alarm, or locksmith business shall be 11 exercised exclusively by the State and may not be exercised 12 13 by any unit of local government, including home rule units. However, this Act does not prohibit a municipality that 14 requires the registration of firearms from imposing that 15 16 requirement on persons licensed under this Act who reside in that municipality. 17
