- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Identification Act is amended by

- 7 Sec. 3.1. <u>Criminal History Record Information</u>.
- 8 (a) The Department may furnish, pursuant to positive

- 11 pursuant to the Private Detective, Private Alarm, Private
- 12 <u>Security</u>, and <u>Locksmith Act of 1993</u> for the purpose of

- 14 Private Detective, Private Alarm, and Private Security Act of

- 16 (b) The Department may furnish, pursuant to positive
- 17 identification, records of convictions to the Illinois Liquor

- 20 in carrying out their duty to refuse to issue licenses to
