- 8 reserved for persons with disabilities. It shall be prohibited to park any motor vehicle 9 which is not properly displaying bearing registration plates 10 or decals issued to a person with disabilities, as defined by 11 Section 1-159.1, pursuant to Sections 3-616, 11-1301.1 or 12 13 11-1301.2, or to a disabled veteran pursuant to Section 3-609 of this Act, as evidence that the vehicle is operated by or 14 15 for a person with disabilities or disabled veteran, in any parking place, including any private or public offstreet 16 parking facility, specifically reserved, by the posting of an 17 18 official sign as designated under Section 11-301, for motor 19 vehicles <u>displaying</u> bearing such registration plates. 20 shall be prohibited to park any motor vehicle in a designated access aisle adjacent to any parking place specifically 21 22 reserved for persons with disabilities, by the posting of an official sign as designated under Section 11-301, for motor 23 24 vehicles displaying bearing such registration plates. When using the parking privileges for persons with disabilities, 25 the parking decal or device must be displayed properly in 26 the vehicle where it is clearly visible to law enforcement personnel, either hanging from the rearview mirror or placed

1 to a disabled person under Sections 3-616, 11-1301.1, or 2 11-1301.2 is in violation of this Section if the person is not the authorized holder of a person with disabilities 3 4 plate or parking decal or device and license is not 5 transporting the authorized holder of a person with б disabilities license plate or parking decal or device to or 7 from the parking location and the person uses the person with 8 disabilities license plate or parking decal or device to 9 exercise any privileges granted through the person with disabilities license plates or parking decals or devices 10 11 under this Code. Any motor vehicle properly displaying bearing a person with disabilities license plate or a person 12 with disabilities parking decal or device containing the 13 International symbol of access issued to persons with 14 15 disabilities by any local authority, state, 16 territory or foreign country shall be recognized by State and local authorities as a valid license plate or device and 17 receive the same parking privileges as residents of this 18 19 State.

- (c) Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this Section shall be fined \$100 in addition to any costs or charges connected with the removal or storage of any motor vehicle authorized under this Section; but municipalities by ordinance may impose a fine up to \$200 and shall display signs indicating the fine imposed. If the amount of the fine is subsequently changed, the municipality shall change the

- 2 be a defense to a charge under this Section that the sign
- 3 posted pursuant to this Section does not comply with the
