AFRICAN AMERICAN LEGISLATORS IN ILLINOIS, 1876-2019

Overview

John W.E. Thomas of Chicago, the first African American Illinois legislator, was elected to the House of Representatives in 1876. A total of 168 African Americans have served in the General Assembly: 20 in the Senate only, 131 in the House only, and 17 in both houses. The first to be elected to the Senate was Adelbert H. Roberts in 1924. In 1927 he also became the first African American to chair a committee—the Senate Committee on Criminal Procedure. The first female African American legislator, Floy Clements, was elected to the House in 1958.

Cecil A. Partee was the first African American President Pro Tempore of the Senate (1971), Minority Leader (1973), and President of the Senate (1975). Corneal A. Davis was the first African American Assistant Minority leader (1971) and Assistant Majority Leader (1975).

Fred J. Smith and Corneal A. Davis each served 36 years in the General Assembly. Smith served 12 years in the House and 24 in the Senate; Davis' entire career was in the House.

Mary E. Flowers is currently the senior African American in the General Assembly. She was elected to the House in 1984 and has served in 18 General Assemblies. Kimberly Lightford, the senior African American senator, started in the Senate in 1998 and has served in 12 General Assemblies. In 2019 she became the first female African American Senate Majority Leader.

The number of African Americans in the General Assembly has gradually risen over the years. The percentage of Illinois legislators who were African American rose due to the reduction in the size of the House in 1983. From 1957 through 1982 the House had 177 members and the Senate had 59. The 23 African Americans who were elected, or continued their 4-year Senate terms, in 1980 made up just over 9.7% of legislators—9.6% in the House (17 members) and 10.2% in the Senate (6 members). After the reduction of the House to 118 members in 1983, African Americans were still 10.2% of the Senate, but rose to 14.4% of the House. The 101st General Assembly has 10 African Americans in the Senate (16.9%) and 21 in the House (17.8%), for an overall percentage of 17.5%.

While Cecil Partee was President Pro Tempore of the Senate, he also apparently became Acting Governor for one day while the Governor and Lieutenant Governor were out of the state. In 2018, Representative Juliana Stratton became the first African-American to be elected as Lieutenant Governor of Illinois.

While Cecil Partee was President Pro Tempore of the Senate, he also apparently became Acting Governor for one day while the Governor and Lieutenant Governor were out of the state. In 2018, Representative Juliana Stratton became the first African-American to be elected as Lieutenant Governor of Illinois.

Appendix A lists all past and present African American legislators, their districts, and the years they served. It notes when a legislator was appointed, resigned, or did not run for re-election (when such information is available).

Appendix B lists leadership and committee leadership positions that African American legislators have held.

Appendix C reports on African American legislators in each General Assembly, starting in 1876. Starting with the 93rd General Assembly (2002-03), it reflects both elected and appointed members (available sources did not consistently report information on appointees to earlier General Assemblies). Appendix C also reports the number of African Americans who were elected to each General Assembly, followed in parentheses by the number (if any) who were appointed.

Appendix D lists the number of General Assemblies served by each African American legislator.

- * Where two adjacent ranges of years are listed for a member, the member's district changed due to redistricting; no interruption in service occurred unless so noted in an endnote.
- † No House districts are shown for the 74th General Assembly, elected in 1964, because all House members were elected at large that year due to the General Assembly's failure to redistrict the House.

Notes on individual members:

- 1. Ethel Skyles Alexander was appointed on July 16, 1986 to fill the vacancy due to the death of Charles Chew Jr.
- Annazette Collins was appointed on December 9, 2000 to fill the vacancy due to the resignation of Representative Coy Pugh. Annazette Collins was appointed on March 14, 2011 to replace Senator Rickey R. Hendon, who resigned on February 24, 2011.
- 3. Kenneth Hall died on March 21, 1995.
- 4. Both Elga L. Jefferies and Mattie Hunter were appointed on December 19, 2002 to replace Senator Margaret Smith. Elga L. Jefferies held the seat until January 8, 2003, when Mattie Hunter was sworn in. Later, in 2006, Elga L. Jefferies was appointed to complete the term of the late Representative Lovana "Lou" Jones.
- 5. Emil Jones Jr. did not run for re-election in 2008.
- 6. Elgie R. Sims Jr. was appointed on August 3, 2012 to replace Constance A. "Connie" Howard, who had resigned. He was appointed to the Senate on January 26, 2018 to fill the vacancy due to Donne Trotter's resignation. He was elected in 2018 to the 101st General Assembly.
- 7. Senator Margaret Smith resigned on December 12, 2002.
- 8. Senator Donne E. Trotter was appointed on December 1, 1988 to replace Carol Moseley Braun, who had resigned to become Cook County Recorder of Deeds. He resigned his seat on January 19, 2018 and was replaced by then-Representative Elgie R. Sims Jr.
- 9. Harold Washington was elected to Congress and resigned his seat in the General Assembly on January 5, 1981.
- Christopher R. Belt was appointed on January 4, 2019 to fill the vacancy after James Clayborne's resignation from the 100th General Assembly. He was elected to the 101st General Assembly in 2018.
- 11. Charles Chew Jr. died July 3, 1986.
- 12. James F. Clayborne Jr. was appointed on April 17, 1995 to fill the vacancy due to the death of Kenneth Hall. He did not run for re-election in 2018, and resigned on December 31, 2018. Christopher R. Belt was appointed to fill the vacancy for the 100th General Assembly. He was elected to the 101st General Assembly in 2018.
- 13. Both Elga L. Jefferies and Mattie Hunter were appointed on December 19, 2002 to replace Margaret Smith, who had resigned December 12, 2002. Elga L. Jefferies held the seat until January 8, 2003, when Mattie Hunter was sworn in.

- 14. Toi W. Hutchinson was appointed in January 2009 to replace Debbie Halvorson, who had been elected to the U.S. House of Representatives.
- 15. James T. Meeks was elected in 2002 as an independent, and was re-elected in 2006 as a Democrat.
- 16. Richard H. Newhouse resigned on May 25, 1991.
- 17. Barack Obama was elected to the U.S. Senate in 2004. On November 6, 2004, Kwame Raoul was appointed to replace him.
- 18. Alice J. Palmer was appointed on June 6, 1991 to fill the vacancy due to the resignation of Richard H. Newhouse.
- 19. Robert Peters was appointed on January 6, 2019 to fill the vacancy after Kwame Raoul was elected Attorney General and resigned his Senate seat.
- 20. Kwame Raoul was appointed on November 6, 2004 to fill the seat vacated by U.S. Senator-elect Barack Obama. He was elected Attorney General in 2018 and resigned his Senate seat on January 5, 2019. Robert Peters was appointed to fill the vacancy.
- 21. John D. Anthony was appointed on August 26, 2013 to fill the vacancy due to the resignation of Pam Roth. He resigned June 17, 2016 to take a position in the Department of Corrections.
- 22. Charles F. Armstrong died on March 8, 1965.
- 23. Patricia Bailey resigned on November 29, 2005.
- 24. Eugene M. Barnes resigned January 1, 1980 to become chairman of the Chicago Transit Authority.
- Carol Moseley Braun was elected Cook County Recorder of Deeds, and resigned her seat on December 1, 1988.
- 26. Kambium Buckner was appointed on January 18, 2019 to fill the vacancy after Christian L. Mitchell resigned to serve as Deputy Governor.
- 27. Larry S. Bullock resigned on December 2, 1986.
- 28. Will Burns resigned in May 2011 after being elected a Chicago alderman; Kimberly du Buclet was appointed to fill the vacancy on May 16, 2011.
- 29. Marlow H. Colvin was appointed on October 3, 2001 to complete the term of Todd H. Stroger. He resigned in late March 2012 to take a position as Vice-President for Government Affairs with Commonwealth Edison, and was replaced by the appointment of Marcus C. Evans Jr.
- 30. Melissa Conyears-Ervin filled the vacancy left by the resignation of Pamela Reaves-Harris on January 8, 2017. She was elected to the 100th General Assembly in 2016. On May 3, 2019 she resigned from the House after being elected Chicago City Treasurer. Jawaharial Williams was appointed to the seat following her resignation.
- 31. Monique D. Davis resigned December 30, 2016. Justin Slaughter was appointed on January 5, 2017 to fill the resulting vacancy for both the 99th and 100th General Assemblies.
- 32. Warren B. Douglas was also elected to the 59th General Assembly (1935-37), but died on December 3, 1934 before being sworn in.
- 33. Kimberly du Buclet was appointed on May 16, 2011 to fill the vacancy due to the election of Will Burns as a Chicago alderman, but did not run for re-election.
- 34. Kenneth Dunkin lost the primary election in 2016 to Juliana Stratton, who then won the general election.
- 35. Marcus C. Evans Jr. was appointed to fill the vacancy due to Marlow H. Colvin's resignation.
- 36. Cory Foster was appointed to fill the vacancy due to Karen Yarbrough's election as Cook County Recorder of Deeds. He did not run for election, but returned to his previous position in Governor Quinn's legislative office.

- 37. Calvin L. Giles was appointed on May 18, 1993 to fill the vacancy due to the death of Robert LeFlore Jr. He lost the 2006 Democratic primary election.
