- 7 Sec. 9.04. Warranty disclosures for third-party motor 8 vehicle warranties.
- 9 (a) As used in this Section, "third-party motor vehicle warranty" means an additional warranty, extended service 10 contract, or vehicle protection plan provided by an entity 11 12 that is not the manufacturer of a vehicle.
- (b) A seller that sells or offers for sale a third-party motor vehicle warranty shall, upon the request of the 15 consumer, provide to the consumer:
- 16 (1) a copy of the third-party motor vehicle warranty 17 contract; and
 - (2) a written disclosure provided by the third-party motor vehicle warranty provider summarizing all costs that the consumer may be responsible for under the third-party motor vehicle warranty, including, but not limited to:
- 22 (A) any deductibles, co-pays, or service fees for 2.3 a covered repair;

2	reimbursements;
3	(C) any costs or services that are not covered
