3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 1, on page 1, line 5, by deleting "6-203.1,"; and

5 on page 1, line 6, after "6-208" by inserting "and by adding
6 Section 6-203.2"; and

7 by replacing line 10 on page 5 through line 12 on page 6 with
8 the following:

9 "(625 ILCS 5/6-203.2 new)

10 Sec. 6-203.2. Credit for ignition interlock use. A person
11 whose license was suspended and was issued a monitoring device
12 driving permit under Section 6-206.1 and who is subsequently
13 convicted of the underlying charge, for the same incident,
14 shall be given credit for time served on the monitoring device
15 driving permit toward any mandatory ignition interlock

1 requirement resulting from the conviction if the person had no
2 ignition interlock violations, as defined by the Secretary,
3 while on the monitoring device driving permit."
