1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3268 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 3268 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by adding 4 Section 6.5 as follows: 5 6 (225 ILCS 10/6.5 new) Sec. 6.5. Qualifications for early childhood teachers. 7 (a) Until June 30, 2030, a licensed day care center may 8 hire an individual who is in the process of completing the 9 10 educational requirements set forth in 89 Ill. Adm. Code 407.140(c) as an Interim Conditional Early Childhood Teacher. 11 An individual hired pursuant to this Section shall provide 12 documentation that shows that the individual has completed the 13 Gateways to Opportunity Level 1 Credential and is enrolled in 14 15 courses that meet the requirements set forth in 89 Ill. Adm.

Code 407.140(c). The individual shall be enrolled in an

- (b) An Interim Conditional Early Childhood Teacher with any of the following qualifications is exempt from the educational requirements set forth in 89 Ill. Adm. Code 407.140(c):
 - (1) At least one year or 1,560 clock hours of child development experience in a nursery school, kindergarten, or licensed day care center and at least 30 semester hours or 45 quarter hours of credits from an accredited college or university with 3 semester hours or 4.5 quarter hours in courses related directly to child care or child development from birth to age 6. A person who qualifies under this paragraph (1) shall obtain the remaining 3 semester hours or 4.5 quarter hours during the following 12-month period.
 - (2) At least 2 years or 3,120 clock hours of child development experience in a nursery school, kindergarten, or licensed day care center and at least 30 semester hours or 45 quarter hours of credits from an accredited college or university without the 6 semester hours or 9 quarter hours in courses related directly to child care or child development from birth to age 6. A person who qualifies under this paragraph (2) shall obtain the 6 semester hours or 9 quarter hours during the following 12-month period.
 - (3) Employment with the program for at least one year
