SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-302

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-302

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the Department of Transportation shall install a lighted stop sign at any intersection where 2 stop sign violations that resulted in either a fatality or an infliction of great bodily harm have occurred within a 3-month period.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing Section 11-302 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-302) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-302)
- Sec. 11-302. Authority to designate through highway and stop and yield intersections.
- 9 (a) The Department with reference to State highways under its jurisdiction, and local authorities with reference to 10 other highways under their jurisdiction, may designate through 11 highways and erect stop signs or yield signs at specified 12 13 entrances thereto, or may designate any intersection as a stop 14 intersection or as a yield intersection and erect stop signs or yield signs at one or more entrances to such intersection. 15 16 Designation of through highways and stop intersections and the erection of stop signs or yield signs on 17 township or road district roads are subject to the written 18 19 approval of the county engineer or superintendent of highways.
 - (a-5) The Department shall install a lighted stop sign at any intersection where 2 stop sign violations that resulted in either a fatality or an infliction of great bodily harm have occurred within a 3-month period.

- (b) Every stop sign and yield sign shall conform to the State Manual and Specifications and shall be located as near as practicable to the nearest line of the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, if there is no crosswalk, then as close as practicable to the nearest line of the intersecting roadway.
 - (c) The Department may in its discretion and when traffic conditions warrant such action give preference to traffic upon any of the State highways under its jurisdiction over traffic crossing or entering such highway by erecting appropriate traffic control devices.
