1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3435 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 3435 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Uniform Emergency Volunteer Health 4 5 Practitioners Act is amended by changing Section 6 as follows: 6 (225 ILCS 140/6) 7 Sec. 6. Recognition of volunteer health practitioners 8 licensed in other states. While an emergency declaration is in effect, a 9 volunteer health practitioner, registered with a registration 10 system that complies with Section 5 and licensed and in good 11

standing in the state upon which the practitioner's

registration is based, may practice in this State to the

extent authorized by this Act as if the practitioner were

licensed in this State. If a state licensed health or mental

health professional with a valid license from another state or

- 1 territory is operating under the auspices of the American Red
- 2 Cross, the professional may practice in this State to the
- 3 <u>extent authorized by this Act as if the practitioner were</u>
- 4 licensed in this State, regardless of whether an emergency
- 5 declaration is in effect.
- 6 (b) A volunteer health practitioner qualified under
- 7 subsection (a) is not entitled to the protections of this Act
- 8 if any license of the practitioner is suspended, revoked, or
- 9 subject to an agency order limiting or restricting practice
- 10 privileges, or has been voluntarily terminated under threat of
- 11 sanction.
