

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 10. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by  
5 changing Section 3.7 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 10/3.7)

7 Sec. 3.7. Exemption from licensure; day care homes and  
8 group day care homes serving children of military personnel.  
9 Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, a day  
10 care home or group day care home may be exempt from licensure  
11 if it meets all of the following requirements ~~is not required~~  
12 ~~to be licensed under this Act if the day care home or group day~~  
13 ~~care home:~~ (1) it serves dependent children of military  
14 personnel; (2) it is located on a military base or federal or  
15 government property; and (3) it is certified as a child  
16 development program by a branch of the U.S. Department of  
17 Defense or the U.S. Coast Guard. The U.S. Department of  
18 Defense or the U.S. Coast Guard, or their agents, including an  
19 installation commander of a military base on which a day care  
20 home or group day care home is located, may assume  
21 responsibility for monitoring the day care homes or group day  
22 care homes that are exempt from licensure under this Section.
