SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/355.5

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Removes provision stating that fees incurred directly by a dental care provider from third parties related to transmitting an automated clearing house network claim, transaction management, data management, or portal services and other fees charged by third parties that are not in the control of the dental plan carrier shall not be prohibited. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by changing Section 355.5 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/355.5)
- Sec. 355.5. Dental coverage reimbursement; prohibitions. 8 No insurer, dental service plan corporation, professional 9 service corporation, insurance network leasing company, or any company that amends, delivers, issues, or renews an individual 10 or group policy of accident and health insurance on or after 11 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 103rd General 12 Assembly shall require a dental care provider to incur a fee to 13 14 access and obtain payment or reimbursement for services provided. A dental plan carrier shall provide a dental care 15 provider with 100% of the contracted amount of the payment or 16 17 reimbursement. Fees incurred directly by a dental from third parties related to transmitting 18 automated clearing house network claim, transaction 19 management, data management, or portal services and other fees 20 21 charged by third parties that are not in the control of the dental plan carrier shall not be prohibited by this Section. 22
