2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3605, AS AMENDED,
3 by inserting immediately below the enacting clause the
4 following:

16 Section with respect to Sections 370c and 370c.1 and Article
17 XXXIIB of the Illinois Insurance Code; all other requirements
18 of this Section shall be enforced by the Department of Central
19 Management Services.

3 "Section 95. No acceleration or delay. Where this Act
4 makes changes in a statute that is represented in this Act by
5 text that is not yet or no longer in effect (for example, a
6 Section represented by multiple versions), the use of that
7 text does not accelerate or delay the taking effect of (i) the
8 changes made by this Act or (ii) provisions derived from any
9 other Public Act."
