#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2105/2105-410 new

Amends the Department of Professional Regulation Law. Provides that when a licensee applies to renew a license, the Division of Professional Regulation of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation shall deem the licensee's renewal fee to have been paid if the licensee can provide proof that the licensee's total annual income for the preceding calendar year was less than \$50,000. Provides that renewal forms adopted by the Division shall include language informing licensees that the renewal fee shall be deemed paid if a licensee can prove that the licensee made less than \$50,000 in total annual income in the preceding calendar year. Provides that a W-2 form, or similar tax document, stating that a licensee made less than \$50,000 in total annual income in the preceding year shall be sufficient evidence that the licensee made less than \$50,000 in total annual income in the preceding calendar year.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Department of Professional Regulation Law  
5 of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by  
6 adding Section 2105-410 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2105/2105-410 new)

8 Sec. 2105-410. Renewal fee waiver.

9 (a) When a licensee applies to renew a license, the  
10 Department shall deem the licensee's renewal fee to have been  
11 paid if the licensee can provide proof that the licensee's  
12 total annual income for the preceding calendar year was less  
13 than \$50,000.

14 (b) Renewal forms adopted by the Department shall include  
15 language informing licensees that the renewal fee shall be  
16 deemed paid if a licensee can prove that the licensee made less  
17 than \$50,000 in total annual income in the preceding calendar  
18 year.

19 (c) A W-2 form, or similar tax document, stating that a  
20 licensee made less than \$50,000 in total annual income in the  
21 preceding year shall be sufficient evidence that the licensee  
22 made less than \$50,000 in total annual income in the preced ing  
23 calendar year.
