A BILL FOR

AN ACT concerning appropriations.

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
represented in the General Assembly:**

ARTICLE 1

Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission:

4 Section 5. The amount of \$70,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
6 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois Workers'
7 Compensation Commission for costs associated with the
8 establishment of the Medical Fee Schedule and other provisions
9 of the Workers' Compensation Act.

10 Section 10. The amount of \$9,000, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
12 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois Workers'
13 Compensation Commission for costs associated with the
14 establishment, administration and operations of the Insurance
15 Compliance Division of the workers' compensation anti-fraud
16 program administered by Illinois Workers' Compensation
17 Commission.

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
19 2025.
