SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$340,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Education to address shortages of school psychologists in this State through specified methods. Effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$340,000, or so much of that sum as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the State Board of Education to address shortages of
7 school psychologists in this State by hiring or contracting
8 for a school psychology liaison within the State Board of
9 Education, providing a grant to fund a program within the
10 Illinois School Psychology Internship Consortium to recruit
11 and retain doctoral interns in faculty positions within public
12 universities, and funding a school psychologist retention
13 program with a group consultation model.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
15 2025.
