SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

775 ILCS 50/10

Amends the Human Trafficking Resource Center Notice Act. Requires the notice required under the Act to contain images of the Signal for Help hand signal. Effective January 1, 2027.

1 AN ACT concerning human rights.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Human Trafficking Resource Center Notice
- 5 Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (775 ILCS 50/10)
- 7 Sec. 10. Form of posted notice.
- 8 (a) The notice required under this Act shall be at least 8
- 9 1/2 inches by 11 inches in size, written in a 16-point font,
- 10 except that when the notice is provided by electronic means
- 11 the size of the notice and font shall not be required to comply
- 12 with these specifications, and shall state the following:
- "If you or someone you know is being forced to engage in any
- 14 activity and cannot leave, whether it is commercial sex,
- 15 housework, farm work, construction, factory, retail, or
- 16 restaurant work, or any other activity, call the National
- 17 Human Trafficking Resource Center at 1-888-373-7888 to access
- 18 help and services.
- 19 Victims of slavery and human trafficking are protected under
- 20 United States and Illinois law. The hotline is:
- * Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

- * Toll-free.
- * Operated by nonprofit nongovernmental organizations.
- * Anonymous and confidential.
- * Accessible in more than 160 languages.
- * Able to provide help, referral to services,
- 6 training, and general information.".
- 7 The notice shall contain 2 images of the Signal for Help
- 8 hand signal. The first image shall detail an open palm with a
- 9 <u>tucked thumb and the words "1. Palm to and thumb tuck."</u>
- 10 displayed under the image. The second image shall detail a
- 11 trapped thumb with a closed fist and the words "2. Trap thumb."
- 12 displayed under the image.
- 13 (b) The notice shall be printed in English, Spanish, and
- in one other language that is the most widely spoken language
- in the county where the establishment is located and for which
- translation is mandated by the federal Voting Rights Act, as
- 17 applicable. This subsection does not require a business or
- 18 other establishment in a county where a language other than
- 19 English or Spanish is the most widely spoken language to print
- the notice in more than one language in addition to English and
- 21 Spanish.

- 23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
- 24 1, 2027.
