October of each year as Charlie Kirk Day.

1 AN ACT concerning government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
5 adding Section 197 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 490/197 new)

7 Sec. 197. Charlie Kirk Day. The 14th day of October of each
8 year is designated as Charlie Kirk Day, to be observed
9 throughout the State as a day set apart to honor the life and
10 legacy of Illinois native Charlie Kirk who dedicated his life
11 to protecting First Amendment principles and encouraging
12 peaceful, open, and civil discourse.
