SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates the sum of \$20,000,000 from the Capital Projects Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for expenses associated with the restoration of the property formerly operated as the Joliet Correctional Center. Effective July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital Projects
6 Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
7 for expenses associated with the restoration of the property
8 formerly operated as the Joliet Correctional Center, including
9 but not limited to, site preparation, environmental
10 assessments, demolition of existing structures, environmental
11 remediation, site stabilization activities, site restoration
12 activities, and other work directly related to the demolition
13 process, as deemed necessary to support infrastructure renewal
14 and development, including prior year costs.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
16 2026.
