SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 414/0.5 new
815 ILCS 414/1.6 new

Amends the Ticket Sale and Resale Act. Provides that a ticket seller or ticket reseller shall display the full price of a ticket, including all assessed fees, to a consumer when the price of a ticket is first shown to the consumer and shall not increase that price during the transaction with the consumer. Provides that a ticket reseller shall not sell or offer to sell a ticket that the ticket reseller does not possess or have a contract to purchase. Provides that the Attorney General shall set up a complaint system for consumers to report violations. Defines terms.

1 AN ACT concerning business.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Ticket Sale and Resale Act is amended by
5 adding Sections 0.5 and 1.6 as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 414/0.5 new)

7 Sec. 0.5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

8 "Reseller" or "ticket reseller" means a person engaged in
9 the resale of tickets.

10 "Seller" or "ticket seller" means a person who has the
11 right to sell a ticket prior to or at the primary sale of the
12 ticket, including the event organizer or a person that
13 provides services to conduct or facilitate the primary sale of
14 tickets by or on behalf of the event organizer.

15 "Ticket" means a physical, electronic, or other form of a
16 certificate, document, voucher, token, or other evidence
17 indicating that a person has the right to be admitted to an
18 event.

20 Sec. 1.6. Consumer protections for ticket sales.

21 (a) A ticket seller or ticket reseller shall display the
22 full price of a ticket, including all assessed fees, to a

1 consumer when the price of a ticket is first shown to the
2 consumer and shall not increase that price during the
3 transaction with the consumer, except that physical delivery
4 costs and any taxes imposed by this State or a unit of local
5 government shall be added to the total price of a ticket when
6 the consumer provides an address to the ticket seller or
7 ticket reseller.

8 (b) A ticket reseller shall not sell or offer to sell a
9 ticket that the ticket reseller does not possess or have a
10 contract to purchase. This subsection does not apply to a
11 ticket procurement service that makes a clear and conspicuous
12 disclosure to the consumer concerning the nature of the
13 service being provided to the consumer.

14 (c) The Attorney General shall establish a system for
15 consumers to submit reports concerning violations of this
16 Section. The Attorney General shall review the submitted
17 reports for enforcement of this Section.
