1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4984

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4984 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Ticket Sale and Resale Act is amended by
5 adding Sections 0.5 and 1.6 as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 414/0.5 new)

7 Sec. 0.5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

8 "Reseller" or "ticket reseller" means a person engaged in
9 the resale of tickets.

10 "Ticket" means a physical, electronic or other form of a
11 certificate, document, voucher, token, or other evidence
12 indicating that a person has the right to be admitted to an
13 event at a specific time for a specific seat or area.

14 (815 ILCS 414/1.6 new)

15 Sec. 1.6. Prohibition on selling tickets not in the

1 reseller's possession.

2 (a) A ticket reseller shall not sell or offer to sell a
3 ticket that the ticket reseller does not possess or have a
4 written, binding contract to purchase at the time of the sale
5 or offer for sale.

6 (b) A violation of this Section constitutes an unlawful
7 practice under the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
8 Practices Act. All remedies, penalties, and authority granted
9 to the Attorney General by the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive
10 Business Practices Act shall be available to the Attorney
11 General for the enforcement of this Section.

12 Section 10. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
13 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2MMMM as follows:

14 (815 ILCS 505/2MMMM new)

15 Sec. 2MMMM. Violations of the Ticket Sale and Resale Act.
16 Any person who violates Section 1.6 of the Ticket Sale and
17 Resale Act commits an unlawful practice within the meaning of
18 this Act.

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
20 becoming law.".
