1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5132

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 5132 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Section 3-107 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-107) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-107)

7 Sec. 3-107. Contents and effect.

8 (a) Each certificate of title issued by the Secretary of
9 State shall contain:

10 1. the date issued;

11 2. the name and address of the owner;

12 3. the names, addresses, and fax numbers or electronic
13 addresses of any lienholders, in the order of priority as
14 shown on the application or, if the application is based
15 on a certificate of title, as shown on the certificate;

16 4. the title number assigned to the vehicle;

1 5. a description of the vehicle including, so far as
2 the following data exists: its make, year-model,
3 identifying number, type of body, whether new or used, as
4 to house trailers as defined in Section 1-128 of this
5 Code, and as to manufactured homes as defined in Section
6 1-144.03 of this Code, the square footage of the vehicle
7 based upon the outside dimensions excluding the length of
8 the tongue and hitch, and, if a new vehicle, the date of
9 the first sale of the vehicle for use;

10 6. an odometer certification as provided for in this
11 Code; and

12 7. any other data the Secretary of State prescribes.

13 (a-3) The description of a vehicle under paragraph 5 of
14 subsection (a) in a certificate of title for a specially
15 constructed vehicle containing a motor shall state how the
16 vehicle was constructed, including the origin, make, model,
17 year, and identification numbers of the major component parts
18 used to construct the specially constructed vehicle.

19 As used in this subsection:

20 "Major component part" includes the chassis, frame, cab,
21 shell, kit, engine block, engine casing, transmission, and
22 unitized body supporting structure.

23 "Specially constructed vehicle" means a vehicle of a type
24 required to be registered that has been materially altered
25 from its original construction and body style by the removal,
26 addition, or substitution of major component parts from 2 or

1 more vehicles or motorcycles of a different make, model, or
2 year.

3 (a-5) In the event the applicant seeks to have the vehicle
4 titled as a custom vehicle or street rod, that fact must be
5 stated in the application. The custom vehicle or street rod
6 must be inspected as required by Section 3-406 of this Code
7 prior to issuance of the title. Upon successful completion of
8 the inspection, the vehicle may be titled in the following
9 manner. The make of the vehicle shall be listed as the make of
10 the actual vehicle or the make it is designed to resemble
11 (e.g., Ford or Chevrolet); the model of the vehicle shall be
12 listed as custom vehicle or street rod; and the year of the
13 vehicle shall be listed as the year the actual vehicle was
14 manufactured or the year it is designed to resemble. A vehicle
15 previously titled as other than a custom vehicle or street rod
16 may be issued a corrected title reflecting the custom vehicle
17 or street rod model if it otherwise meets the requirements for
18 the designation.

19 (a-10) In the event the applicant seeks to have the
20 vehicle titled as a glider kit, that fact must be stated in the
21 application. The glider kit must be inspected under Section
22 3-406 of this Code prior to issuance of the title. Upon
23 successful completion of the inspection, the vehicle shall be
24 titled in the following manner: (1) the make of the vehicle
25 shall be listed as the make of the chassis or the make it is
26 designed to resemble; (2) the model of the vehicle shall be

1 listed as glider kit; and (3) the year of the vehicle shall be
2 listed as the year presented on the manufacturer's certificate
3 of origin for the chassis, unless no year is presented, then it
4 shall be listed as the year the application was received. The
5 vehicle identification number of the chassis shall be assigned
6 to the engine, transmission, and rear axle if the engine,
7 transmission, and rear axle were not previously assigned a
8 vehicle identification number after an inspection under
9 Section 3-406.

10 (b) The certificate of title shall contain forms for
11 assignment and warranty of title by the owner, and for
12 assignment and warranty of title by a dealer, and may contain
13 forms for applications for a certificate of title by a
14 transferee, the naming of a lienholder and the assignment or
15 release of the security interest of a lienholder.

16 (b-5) The Secretary of State shall designate on a
17 certificate of title a space where the owner of a vehicle may
18 designate a beneficiary, to whom ownership of the vehicle
19 shall pass in the event of the owner's death.

20 (c) A certificate of title issued by the Secretary of
21 State is prima facie evidence of the facts appearing on it.

22 (d) A certificate of title for a vehicle is not subject to
23 garnishment, attachment, execution or other judicial process,
24 but this subsection does not prevent a lawful levy upon the
25 vehicle.

26 (e) Any certificate of title issued by the Secretary of

1 State is subject to a lien in favor of the State of Illinois
2 for any fees or taxes required to be paid under this Act and as
3 have not been paid, as provided for in this Code.

4 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
5 certificate of title issued by the Secretary of State to a
6 manufactured home is prima facie evidence of the facts
7 appearing on it, notwithstanding the fact that such
8 manufactured home, at any time, shall have become affixed in
9 any manner to real property.
