SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

705 ILCS 17/20

Amends the Supreme Court Historic Preservation Act. Provides that on July 1, 2026, or as soon thereafter as may be practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer the amount of \$900,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Supreme Court Historic Preservation Fund. Effective July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning courts.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Supreme Court Historic Preservation Act is
5 amended by changing Section 20 as follows:

6 (705 ILCS 17/20)

7 Sec. 20. Supreme Court Historic Preservation Fund.

8 (a) The Supreme Court Historic Preservation Fund is
9 created as a special fund in the State treasury. Subject to
10 appropriation, the moneys in the Fund shall be used only by the
11 Commission as deemed appropriate for historic preservation and
12 related purposes, including the hiring of necessary staff.

13 (b) All moneys received by the Commission, including
14 without limitation, grants, gifts, donations, bequests, fees,
15 admissions, sales, and concessions, from any source, including
16 private, public, governmental, and individual, must be
17 deposited into the Fund. All interest that is attributable to
18 moneys in the Fund must be deposited into the Fund.

19 (c) On July 1, 2026 ~~2007~~, or as soon thereafter as may be
20 practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer the amount of
21 \$900,000 ~~\$5,000,000~~ from the General Revenue Fund to the
22 Supreme Court Historic Preservation Fund.
