SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations from various funds to the Office of the Attorney General for its ordinary and contingent expenses and for other specified purposes in State fiscal year 2027. Effective July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$100,700,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to meet its
7 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027.

8 Section 10. The sum of \$11,000,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
10 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for payment of
11 awards and grants under the Violent Crime Victims Assistance
12 Act.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for disbursement to
16 the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation for use as provided in
17 the Illinois Equal Justice Act.

18 Section 20. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
20 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for ordinary and
21 contingent expenses and operational programs of the Medicaid

1 Fraud Control Unit.

2 Section 25. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
4 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for grants for
5 organized retail crime enforcement.

6 Section 30. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
8 fund to the Office of the Attorney General for ordinary and
9 contingent expenses and operational programs of the Child
10 Support Enforcement Division.

11 Section 35. The sum of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Access to Justice
13 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for disbursement to
14 the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation pursuant to the Access
15 to Justice Act.

16 Section 40. The sum of \$1,150,000, or so much thereof as is
17 available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated to
18 the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law Enforcement
19 Fund for State law enforcement purposes.

20 Section 45. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Attorney

1 General from the Domestic Violence Fund pursuant to Public Act
2 95-711 for grants to public or private nonprofit agencies for
3 the purposes of facilitating or providing free domestic
4 violence legal advocacy, assistance, or services to victims of
5 domestic violence who are married or formerly married or
6 parties or former parties to a civil union related to order of
7 protection proceedings, or other proceedings for civil
8 remedies for domestic violence.

9 Section 50. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General
11 Tobacco Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for the
12 oversight, enforcement, and implementation of the Master
13 Settlement Agreement entered in the case of People of the
14 State of Illinois v. Philip Morris, et al (Circuit Court of
15 Cook County, No. 96L13146), for the administration and
16 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act,
17 for the handling of tobacco-related litigation, and for other
18 law enforcement activities of the Attorney General.

19 Section 55. The sum of \$11,850,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General
21 Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment Projects Fund
22 to the Office of the Attorney General for use in the
23 performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the
24 duties of the Attorney General, including State law

1 enforcement and public education.

2 Section 60. The sum of \$4,500,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Charity
4 Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to enforce
5 the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act and to
6 gather and disseminate information about charitable trustees
7 and organizations to the public.

8 Section 65. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General
10 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Office of the
11 Attorney General for ordinary and contingent expenses,
12 including State law enforcement purposes.

13 Section 70. The sum of \$15,540,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General's
15 State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund to the
16 Attorney General for use in the performance of any function
17 pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the Attorney
18 General, including State law enforcement and public education.

19 Section 75. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Cannabis
21 Expungement Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for
22 disbursement to the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation for use

1 as provided in the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act.

2 Section 80. The sum of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Violent Crime
4 Victims Assistance Fund to the Office of the Attorney General
5 for the payment of awards and grants under the Violent Crime
6 Victims Assistance Act.

7 Section 85. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Violent Crime Victims
9 Assistance Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for
10 grants to public or private nonprofit agencies for the
11 purposes of facilitating or providing free domestic violence
12 legal advocacy, assistance, or services to victims of domestic
13 violence who are married or formerly married, or who are
14 parties or former parties to a civil union, related to an order
15 of protection proceeding or other proceeding for civil
16 remedies for domestic violence.

17 Section 90. The sum of \$175,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General Sex
19 Offender Awareness, Training, and Education Fund to the Office
20 of the Attorney General to administer the I-SORT program and
21 to alert and educate the public, victims, and witnesses of
22 their rights under various victim notification laws, and for
23 training law enforcement agencies, State's Attorneys, and

1 medical providers regarding their legal duties concerning the
2 prosecution and investigation of sex offenses.

3 Section 95. The sum of \$11,000,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General
5 Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for
6 funding for federal grants.

7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
8 2026.
